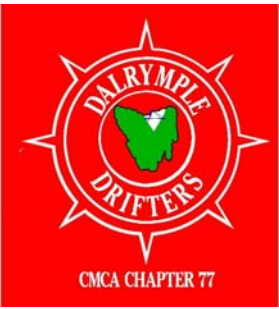
Hopefully the same appetites will be wet for the April Rally (Safari) that Jenni & Kevin are planning for April next year.
